IOWA STATE TRAPSHOOTING ASSOCIATION

Annual Fall Board Meeting November 3, 2012

President Dennis Dozark called the Annual Fall Board Meeting of the Iowa State Trapshooting Association to order at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, November 3, 2012, in a meeting room at the Holiday Inn, Ames, Iowa.

Present were: President Dennis Dozark, SW Zone Director Jon Peterson, NW Zone Director Jim Cole, SE Zone Director Mick Friedel and NE Zone Director Kevin Hartwig; Alternate Zone Directors Dave Wickman, Dan Schlicher and Doug Brower, ATA Delegate Lori Wickman; AIM Co-Director Robert Doerres, and Secretary/Treasurer Debra Oelmann. Absent: ATA Alternate Delegates Dan Wood and Dennis Bigelow.

The minutes of the July 29, 2012 Annual Membership Meeting were read. Some corrections need to be made. These minutes will be approved at the 2013 State Shoot Membership Meeting.

The financial statements through October 28, 2012, were then reviewed by Deb. Total income as of 10/28/12 is \$368,829.84. Total expenses as of 10/28/12 are \$318,023.02. This leaves an overall net profit to date of \$50,806.82. Deb advised the Board that on 10/31/12 sales tax was paid of \$15,404 of which \$1,464 was paid on the trophies purchased. This brings our overall net profit to date to \$35,402.82. This net profit does include the sales tax capital campaign donations of \$13,399.80. The 2012 high school shoot, state shoot and central zone shoot income statements were reviewed. Our net profit from the high school shoot was \$15,917, net profit from the state shoot was \$34,408, and a net loss from the central zone shoot was \$3,561. The cost for the rural water installation was \$6,345 of which the Cedar Falls Gun Club paid one-half or \$3,172.50.

A discussion was held on the cost of trap help. Denny Dozark did some figuring and the state shoot can be worked with 65-70 employees. This year we had 15 extra employees. Wendy will be given \$35,000 for trap help and will need to employ help accordingly. Also, bonuses will be affected if the trap houses are not cleaned out properly.

Robert Doerres then discussed the AIM Program and a bill he paid from Shamrock Leathers in the amount of \$438 for AIM trophies. In February of 2010, \$3,000 from the youth fund was allocated to be used within the AIM Program based on the recommendations of the AIM subcommittee. The AIM Program has spent approx. \$450 of this \$3,000 and asks that Bob Doerres be reimbursed the \$348 for AIM trophies. This \$3,000 was not be used for the new scholarship program implemented this past spring. Jon Petersen moved to reimburse Bob Doerres \$348 for AIM trophies per the original motion in the 2010 minutes, seconded by Mick Friedel, motion carried.

A discussion was had on funding the AIM Program, the scholarship program, etc. Jon Peterson moved to zero out the \$3,000 allocated from the youth fund as approved in February of 2010. Then on an annual basis from the youth fund, beginning January 1, 2013, set up an account for AIM promotion with \$750. Then at the beginning of each year this account will be

funded so there is a \$750 beginning balance. Also, a separate scholarship fund will be set up with a balance of \$2,000 placed in this account at the beginning of each year from the youth fund. This motion was seconded by Mick Friedel, motion carried.

Regarding the sales and use tax audit, Jim Cole moved to accept the terms of the DOR at \$71,000 plus the use tax on trophies for the last three years, seconded by Jon Peterson, motion carried. Our attorney is presently working on the terms of this agreement and hopefully will get us four years to pay interest free.

A discussion was held on trap house repairs. It would be worth our time to pursue grants available for maintenance and repair.

Steve Winkey has resigned as chair of the trophy selection committee. If anyone is interested in selecting trophies for the state shoot, please contact Denny Dozark. ATA is committed to the extra three special categories for three years. The Iowa State Shoot will also continue to give trophies for these extra special categories.

The 2012 All Iowa Trapshooting Teams was discussed. To be eligible for a place on the state teams an application must have been received no later than October 1st by the Secretary-Treasurer. Attached to these minutes is a list of all the applications received and the team each shooter submitting an application has been considered for.

Camping fees for the state shoot were discussed. Jim Cole moved to raise the camping fees to \$140 plus sales tax of \$9.80 or \$149.80, seconded by Jon Peterson, motion carried. This year the high school shoot campers will have water hook-up, therefore the camping fee per night will be \$30 which includes the sales tax.

Lori Wickman discussed the high school shoot for 2013. The high school organization wants more traps available for practice from 7:00-8:00 a.m. Then at 8:00 a.m. when the program starts we will have two practice traps instead of three. This will give them one more program trap. For 2013, the high school shoot will be May 31, and the SCTP shoot will be June 1st and 2nd. The organization would also like the ISTA to furnish the trap help or at least the trap loaders. The Board will contact Wendy to see if she can get 20 kids to work this high school shoot with an approx. cost.

The Board reviewed the financial statements from the last two Central Zone Shoots held at the home grounds and has decided that we are losing money hosting this shoot. If any gun club in the state would like to host this shoot the weekend after the state shoot, they should contact Lori Wickman as soon as possible.

A new event proposal for the 2013 state shoot was presented to the Board by Denny Dozark which would be in place of the Handicap Challenge...a Browning gun lewis on the three championship events. A suggestion would be for the ISTA to purchase 12 BT-99's, and possibly Browning would donate 3-4 BT-99's. The cost would be \$20 to enter. This could be a way to

raise extra funds for help with our sales and use tax audit liability. The Board is to think about this proposal and we will finalize at our spring meeting.

There were complaints at the state shoot regarding having a high gun lewis versus ties divide. We will revisit this at the spring meeting when we finalize the shoot program. The Board decided to use Fine Designs again for t-shirts. However, we need to give them a better location, i.e. where the ambulance parks. Space for the ambulance will be saved east of the clubhouse. For events 1 and 3 which are class events, there should be no champion since these are class events.

A discussion was held on "carts with a steering wheel" brought to the state shoot. A \$10.00 fee will be charged this year for anyone bringing a cart, as well as providing proof of insurance.

TV broadcast at the state shoot was discussed. Denny Dozark will check with the university to see if we could "rent" their license for the week of the shoot.

Denny Dozark is making a contributor plaque for the sales and use tax donations.

Our existing water distribution systems are inadequate and not sized properly for the number of campers and showers (3/4" piping). The pipe is old and needs to be replaced. A new 2" system buried 5' deep is needed. We will pursue the option of this proposal, which will not be inexpensive, but the perpetual repair of the existing system does not appear to be a cost effective way to proceed.

The 2013 shooting schedule was discussed. It was discussed to continue with the 5-day schedule (1,500 targets) as follows. This will be reviewed at our spring meeting when we finalize the shoot program.

Wednesday – 100 singles, 100 handicap, 100 doubles, 100 doubles

Thursday – 100 singles, 100 handicap, 100 doubles, 100 doubles

Friday – 100 doubles champ, 100 handicap, 100 singles

Saturday – 200 singles champ, 100 handicap

Sunday – 100 handicap champ

Lori Wickman made a suggestion per Denny Bigelow that we possibly host a Taylor Morris event and the profits from this event would go to paralyzed veterans. Then the following year would be something different, i.e. breast cancer etc. This will be reviewed at our spring meeting when we finalize the program.

A discussion was held and Gene Zirkelbach will be hired to help Dave Weinberg as a trap mechanic for 2013.

Perry Groen is the Cedar Falls Gun Club President for this upcoming year. He asked about using ISTA traps for league, etc. The Board agreed to continue to trade target for target for their use vs. our use during the state shoot.

The Wisconsin Trapshooting Assn. has asked about holding their state shoot on the Iowa home grounds for 2013. The Wisconsin State Shoot is a week before the Iowa State shoot. More details will be forthcoming regarding this matter.

A discussion was held on gun clubs not collecting membership dues. It was emphasized that all Iowa gun clubs need to be proactive in collecting membership dues from shooters. Gun clubs need to request to see a shooter's valid membership card and if they do not have a valid card, to collect the \$10 annual membership fee. When new membership cards are ordered an email address line will be added so that membership renewal requests can be done by email.

A discussion was held on raising the ISTA daily fees. This will be reviewed at our spring meeting.

The spring ISTA Board meeting has tentatively been set for Saturday, February 23, 2013.

A motion was made by Mick Friedel that the meeting adjourn, seconded by Jon Peterson. Meeting adjourned at 3:20 pm.
