

IOWA STATE TRAPSHOOTING ASSOCIATION

Board Meeting
December 3, 2016

President Denny Dozark called the Board Meeting of the Iowa State Trapshooting Association to order at 10:05 am on Saturday, December 3, 2016, at the Library in Story City. Present were: Denny Dozark, Jim Cole, Kevin Hartwig, John Combs, Doug Brower, Ray Dentlinger, Tom Berry, Heath Kasperbauer, and Debra Oelmann. Absent: Robert Doerres, Dan Wood and Nick Taylor.

The March 19, 2016 Board Meeting minutes were read and approved. The July 24, 2016 Annual Membership Meeting minutes were then read. The current year financial statement was reviewed by Deb. Our checking account bank balance is \$190,548.36. Deb also reviewed with the Board an SCTP Shoot Income Statement wherein our net profit was \$63,132.05. The Iowa State Shoot Income Statement showed a profit of \$51,449.91. Improvements made this year totaled \$86,324.60 which included remodeling the target shed bathrooms, two new trap houses, five new walkways, reblock several trap houses, cut down trees, install the west driveway, repair and replace umbrellas and purchase trap parts.

Denny reviewed the Director voting and meeting participation for the benefit of the new Alternate Director Tom Berry. A copy of the by-laws and articles of incorporation will be mailed to Tom for his review. Denny wants to update the by-laws and articles. He will pursue this with an attorney.

The 2017 zone shoot trophies were then discussed. Kevin Hartwig moved to provide leather bags for zone champion, singles champion, handicap champion and doubles champion. The cost of the bag cash option is eliminated. The zone teams will receive a plaque. The ISTA will also provide five (5) flats of shells to be given four (4) boxes each to the five single class zone winners, the four handicap yardage group zone winners, and the three doubles class zone winners. Finally, nine (9) medals or similar trophy will be provided per zone for singles, handicap and doubles to the sub-junior, junior and junior gold winners, provided the winner does not qualify for a champion, class or yardage trophy. This motion was seconded by John Combs, motion carried.

The 2017 Iowa State Shoot items discussed were as follows:

- The shoot will be held July 18-23 (6 days).
- The order of events will be the same as the 2016 state shoot.
- It has been expressed that shooters would like to receive their payout checks daily. This will be looked into as well as being able to use a credit card for payment of targets and daily fees. Options will need to be paid by check/cash.
- The shoot-off personnel will again be Lori Wickman and Dan Wood.
- The Hawkeye singles on Thursday will be carried over.
- Justin Venner has again agreed to purchase the trophies.
- Presquadding will again be three flights as in the past.

- Event sponsors were discussed. We need to get these finalized before our spring Board meeting.
- Targets shot per trap will be 50.
- The camping rate will be the same at \$140.00 plus sales tax or \$149.80. The fee for vendor/camping will be their vendor fee plus \$75.00 camping.
- Golf cart permits will be required.
- One wagon will be used and two courtesy golf carts to move people around the grounds.
- Trophy pins will be given on All American point events only.

The 2017 AIM State Shoot was then discussed. This will be included with the championship events on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. The ISTA daily fees will be waived as last year. The first year AIM memberships are free and \$5.00 for second and older memberships. Trophies will be awarded to in-state and out-of-state shooters. A discussion was held on how to get more SCTP and AIM shooters to compete at the Iowa State Shoot. This will be revisited at the spring Board meeting.

The 2017 SCTP State Shoot items discussed were as follows:

- The shoot will be held June 7-11 (5 days).
- A first year membership is free and second and older memberships are \$5.00.
- Wendy has agreed to hire the scorers, fillers and trash collectors for the SCTP shoot.
- The ISTA will waive the daily fees for the SCTP shoot. However, the SCTP shooters will be required to pay the ATA daily fees.
- The vendor fee will be \$75.00.
- The camping rate will be \$30.00 per night which includes the tax.
- No golf carts, ATV's or UTV's are allowed except for ISTA and DNR personnel.

New improvement projects were discussed. We will decide at the spring meeting how many walkways we should complete this year. One house roof needs to be repaired because it is cracked. The walkways that will not be replaced, we need to cement an area for the voice calls. The electrical by beer camp was under water during the flood and needs to be repaired. Bill Hesse has MidAmerican and Cedar Falls Utilities at his property. Denny is going to look into the possibility of getting MidAmerican to one-half of our property and use Cedar Falls Utilities for the other one-half. Cedar Falls Gun Club has replaced four trap houses and four walkways. John Combs moved that we pay \$15,000 as a cost share of these improvements, seconded by Kevin Hartwig, motion carried. Repairs to the Bob Allen building were then reviewed. This building needs a sloped roof, new windows, interior remodeling, and electrical as needed.

The Hall of Fame Committee has received three (3) Shooting Merit Resumes for Ken Brandt, Ann Kisner and Beverly Dominacki.

Donations for yardage walkways was discussed. To receive a plaque on a walkway, a donation of \$2,000 needs to be made.

The ISTA presented the Cedar Falls Gun Club with a bill for disputed utilities and trap rental fees. The CFGC reviewed this bill and arrived at an amount to pay the ISTA. After review by the ISTA Board we are in agreement with the amount paid by the CFGC. This matter is now resolved and laid to rest. It also has been decided that the CFGC will be responsible for mowing their used part of the grounds and the ISTA will mow the remaining portion not mowed by the CFGC, pending agreement with CFGC.

Denny stated the farm rent for 2017 will be \$150.00 per planted acre.

The 2016 State Teams were then discussed. An application for membership was required to be sent to Deb by October 1, 2016. This year the ATA's reports sent were by Excel which allowed Deb to sort this report and in a short amount of time was able to figure out the state teams. After discussion, this year only we are going to blend the shooters that sent in an application and the shooters who qualified (transition year). Doug Brower moved that we discontinue the State Team Application for Membership and appoint the attached 2016 State Teams, seconded by Kevin Hartwig, motion carried.

A motion was made by John Combs that the meeting adjourn, seconded by Jim Cole. Meeting adjourned at 2:50 pm.
